Re: Evangelism Project

To Whom It May Concern:

I am sorry to make this such a general letter, but these packets are going out to several friends who have requested them (or at least heard about them), and since we are still in the middle of the project, time is a little cramped.

An explanation of the program is on the inside front cover of the booklet titled "Evangelism Project" and labeled "Beginning Orientation." Since my wording is a little terse and meant only as a reminder to me while I explained it to the class, I will offer some expanded instruction.

The intent is twofold. One is to get the word out to the neighborhoods. The other is to train members in doing some door-to-door work. This is a multi-leveled approach so that people can proceed along in their comfort zone with the hope that as they do it habitually they will grow toward higher levels of confidence. They begin by just doing door hangers at 25 houses per week. As their confidence grows they can actually ring the doorbell. They start with the "Invitation to Attend the Church of Christ" so if confronted, all they have to say is that they are inviting people to church. The rest of the brochures and pamphlets are for their aid in case hard questions are asked. Then all they have to do is hand out the appropriate booklet. The classes/meetings are designed to take them through the booklets so that they know what is in them and to furnish them with the handouts for the next week.

What makes this system unique is that after they go four weeks and visit 100 houses, they go back the next month to the same ones to get people used to their faces and then perhaps by the second or third time, the people may have questions or invite them in. Also it becomes a convenient platform for the work of the church. It can be plugged into the Spring and Fall windows of opportunity. For us the second month handout was a flyer to a Gospel Meeting. This Fall it can be used as an awareness to vote, especially getting people interested in getting back to God to preserve our country.

I hope the rest is self-explanatory. The pdf. files of the pamphlets and brochures will soon appear on the website under "Courses." Hope this helps. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask.
