Oxymoron - The use of contradictory terms for extreme emphasis.

Proverbs 12:10 -- *The tender mercies of the wicked are cruel.*

Paradox - An absurd statement that is none the less true.

Matthew 13:12 -- *Whoever does not have, what he has shall be taken away.*

Personification (and Apostrophe) - To represent something as a person.

Numbers 16:32 -- *The earth opened her mouth.*

Paronomasia - A play on words.

Matthew 8:22 -- *Leave the dead to bury the dead.*

Anthropomorphism (and Anthropopathy) - Attributing the forms and passions of man to God.

Exodus 33:22 -- *I [God] will cover you with my hand.*

10. STUDY TOOLS

Only after one has done his best in his own personal effort to understand God's Word, should he then turn to the Biblical tools for help. The reason is that it is too easy to rely on another man's assumptions and be lead off in ways that may go against what God intended. That is to the negative. To the positive, good tools can properly illuminate, guide down true lines of thinking, make research quicker and more thorough, as well as, confirm what one has already figured out for themselves. Some good study tools are:

English, Greek and Hebrew concordances.

Bible Dictionaries, Handbooks & Bible Encyclopedias.

Bible software.

Interlinear Hebrew and Greek Bibles.

Greek and Hebrew Lexicons (dictionaries).

Greek and Hebrew Grammars & Analytical Lexicons.

Word and Synonym studies (Greek and Hebrew).

Ancient and World History books and Timelines.

Books on Biblical Archeology along with books on Manners and Customs.

Bible Commentaries (Be very careful to get only the very best conservative texts).

Hermeneutical Guides (Works on the Rules of Interpretation).

Writings of Early Christians (Polycarp, Irenaeus, Josephus, Eusebius).
