Introduction:

- A. The battle at Jericho was a great victory!
- B. Our “Jerichos” are fear, anger, bitterness, guilt, and prejudice.
- C. Every promise land inheritance first requires us dispossessing the current residents (Josh 1:11).

I. WE MUST BELIEVE IN GOD’S POWER AND PRESENCE.

- A. The **v**_____ has already been won (Josh 6:2).
- B. We must believe in God’s promises & stop believing Satan’s lies.
- C. We must resist self-labeling and **n**_____ self talk.

II. WE MUST FIGHT WITH GOD’S SPIRITUAL WEAPONS.

- A. God provided a battle strategy which required a deep faith.
- B. “Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven ram’s horns before the ark of the Lord” (Josh 6:6).
- C. We must “Stand against the **w**_____ of the devil” (Eph 6:11).
- D. “The weapons of our warfare, are not **c**_____ but mighty in God for the pulling down of strongholds” (2 Cor 10: 3-4).
- E. A **s**_____ is a *false premise* or belief that blinds us to the truth and gives Satan “a place” in our hearts.

III. WE MUST KEEP GOD AT THE CENTER.

- A. We must march like a *promised land conqueror*.
 - 1. Blast our ram’s horn and sing songs of redemption.
 - 2. Declare **s**_____ of triumph!
- B. Marinate our minds with powerful proclamations!
 - 1. “It is finished” (John 19:31).
 - 2. “Peace be still” (Mark 4:39).
 - 3. “Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world (I John 4:4).
- C. “**R**_____ Satan and he must flee” (Jas 4:8)!

Conclusion:

- A. God told Joshua the walls would fall on the 7th day but the people did not know. They just kept marching by faith and waiting.
- B. The very walls that had kept them out became **s**_____ stones upon which they could climb!
- C. May we all move from *false premises* to reliance on *God’s promises*!
